Voter Instruction Letter

A Voter Instruction Letter (VIL) will be mailed directly to electors and should be received on or before September 25, 2018 (please note timelines have been adjusted due to a possible pending Canada Post strike). If you do not receive a Voter Instruction Letter by October 5th, 2018, please contact the Election Office - 613-386-7351, ext. 120/121.

Additions and revisions to the Voters' List can be made up to and including Election Day. **In order to eliminate lineups and delays, you are encouraged to make additions or revisions to the Voters' List prior to Election Day. Call the voter help line to inquire if you are on the Voters' List.**

eVote – Electronic Voting

You do not need to leave your home or office to vote – simply place your vote using any touch tone telephone (anywhere in North America), or online from any location (anywhere in the world) using your computer, tablet or smartphone with internet connection. The electronic voting period will commence on Monday, October 15 at 10 am and will close on Monday, October 22 at 8 pm. Both systems are available 24 hours a day throughout this period. You are encouraged to **vote early to avoid higher volume activity periods** near the end of the election period. The Voter Instruction Letter will provide each registered elector with a Personal Identification Number (PIN).

If you require assistance to vote, or would like to vote by internet and do not have access at home, you can visit the Voter Assistance Centre (Municipal Office) as follows:
