**RE: Loyalist Township Noise By-law 2011-6, As Amended by By-law 2012-046**


Having reviewed your draft Operations Plan, I wish to provide you with some relevant information in order to help you avoid any unnecessary delays to your project.

Loyalist Township has a noise by-law that regulates, among other items, the noise produced by all types of construction in the Township, including residential, commercial, industrial, or institutional construction. A copy of the by-law is included for your review.

Occasionally, short-term exemptions from the regulations of the noise by-law may be granted. Only Loyalist Township Council has the authority to grant noise by-law exemptions. Requests for exemption will be considered at regular meetings of Council, which are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of each month. Please note that the written request must be received no later than noon, on the Wednesday preceding the scheduled Council meeting.
