Re: Your Letter of December 23, 2016

We received your letter dated December 23, 2016 and the draft Operations Plan.

To be clear, the Township does not consider the Draft Operations Plan attached to the December 23, 2016 letter to be a "Further Draft Plan" as required by Section 36 of the RUA. Your letter of December 23, 2016 is the first indication that you disagreed with the Township's position that the earlier draft did not satisfy the requirements of the Agreement.

The Township does agree that it is in everyone's best interests to move forward with the review of the Draft Operations Plan, and the Township will submit its comments within the 45-day review period as required by the Agreement, assuming this draft includes all the requisite elements for an Operations Plan.

Until the Township completes its review and you submit the required "Further Draft Plan" which addresses any comments, it is premature to schedule the public meeting required by the Agreement. Any public meeting scheduled before the 45-day review period and submission of a "Further Draft Plan" as required by Section 36, will not be recognized by the Township as fulfilling the requirements of the RUA.

In the event you attempt to schedule a public meeting prior to submitting the "Further Draft Plan" in accordance with Section 36, the Township hereby puts you on notice of its intent to submit this issue to dispute resolution in accordance with Part X of the Agreement. In addition, the Township will make it known to the public that any public meeting scheduled in advance of receipt of the "Further Draft Plan" is not a meeting held in accordance with the Agreement and a further public meeting may be required.

We trust that you will agree that the added delay inherent in engaging in dispute resolution and multiple public meetings is not productive. The Township has, at all times, acted in good faith to ensure that this project is not delayed and we are prepared to continue to work with Windlectric in that same spirit of cooperation, but we must act in the best interest of the public and insist on compliance with the Agreement.
