



## Amherst Island Wind Energy Project – Construction Status: February 2018

Loyalist Township wants to keep residents informed about the Amherst Island Wind Project document reviews. We wish to let you know about the status of work completed to date, by Windlectric, Inc. (Windlectric) and their Sub-Contractors

### Recent News

The first turbine has been installed at Stella 40 Foot Road and the bypass road. Many other locations have had the concrete bases poured and are in the process of having the turbine components erected.



Island roads are quite busy with deliveries of tower components, concrete pours and delivery of stone to build access roads.

Residents can expect short duration road closures on all affected roads in the coming weeks as turbine components are moved from the staging yard on 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession Road to their final destinations.

Component moves take additional time on Stella 40 Foot Road due to the hill at St. Paul's Presbyterian Church. Road closures at this location will be for an extended duration to allow equipment to traverse the hill.

Island roads continue to be improved by the Contractor. The Contractor is milling out the old road platform before installing Combigrid (a woven cloth that adds strength to the road bed). New granular is then being placed and compacted to return the road to its pre-existing grade.

To date the following roads are complete:

- Stella 40 Foot Road
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession Road
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Concession Road
- South Shore Road
- Lower 40 Foot Road

Work is still ongoing on Front Road and should be completed in the coming weeks.



The Contractor will be returning to all affected roads to complete culvert replacements as required at a later date.
