Executive Summary:

Council instructed staff to undertake an accessible transit service survey to determine the demand for accessible transit in Amherstview. The survey was prepared by staff, and made available for public response for approximately four weeks in May and June. Results have been compiled and are attached to this report for Council's review.

Recommendation:

That the report from the Interim Public Works Supervisor, June 26, 2019, re: Accessible Transit Survey Results, be received for information.

Background:

At their regular session on February 8, 2019, Council passed the following resolution:

Resolution 2019.03.8

Moved by Deputy Mayor Hegadorn and Seconded by Councillor Porter that the report from the Interim Public Works Supervisor, January 10, 2019, re: Accessible Transit be received for information; and That the Public Works Division undertake a public consultation process including a public meeting for the purpose of determining the demand for accessible transportation in Amherstview.

Motion carried.

In accordance with Council's resolution, staff prepared a survey comprised of 19 questions and comment sections. The survey was available online and in paper format. The online version, on the SurveyMonkey platform, was open for responses from Monday, May 13 until Monday, June 10th. A paper copy of the survey was mailed to anyone who requested it, along with a stamped envelope to enable them to return it to the Township. Staff allowed until Thursday, June 20th for paper responses to be returned. Multiple copies of the paper surveys were also delivered to the three nursing and/or retirement homes in Amherstview.

Posters advertising the survey were distributed to various businesses and public service agency locations within Amherstview, and specific organizations providing services to individuals with disabilities. Staff advertised the survey in Kingston This Week on May 9 and May 23, and posters were placed in all of the bus shelters throughout Amherstview. A news story about the survey was posted in the Latest News section of the Township's website, and the Township's social media channels were also used to inform the public about the survey.

Status:

The SurveyMonkey survey platform allows users to create surveys, receive and organize responses, and output the results in various formats. The summary of survey results as presented in the appendix to this report has been prepared by SurveyMonkey and makes initial review of the data easily understandable.

There were 128 responses to the survey, including mailed hand delivered paper responses. Of these, 67 responses were from individuals who identified themselves as having a disability or completing the survey on behalf of someone with a disability. Those with disabilities indicated a wide range of disabilities and the need for various types of mobility aids. Respondents indicated whether or not they had used the Route 10 bus in the past, accessible taxis, or a specialized accessible service similar to the Kingston Access Bus. They were also asked their estimated frequency of use of a specialized service, should it be available and whether it would improve their lifestyle. Respondents could identify themselves to allow for follow up with Township staff as might be required.

An additional section was provided at the end of the survey to offer any additional thoughts or comments regarding accessible transit in Amherstview. Respondents used this opportunity to comment on aspects of the current Route 10 service and possible improvements from their perspective.

Analysis:

At the time of the writing of this report, the results have only been examined to redact any identifying personal information. No other analysis has yet been undertaken.

Options:

Following the July 8 Council meeting the results of the survey, as attached herewith, will be released to the public on the Township's website. An information page intended to anticipate additional queries, will be included.

Staff intend to move forward to conduct a detailed analysis of the survey responses and consult with industry contacts in the weeks ahead, with the intention that a report to Council with options and recommendations would be tabled later this fall.

Consultation:

The Public Works Manager was consulted in the preparation of this report. With respect to the survey preparation, the Public Works Manager, the Corporate Communications and New Initiatives Coordinator, and Infrastructure Services Administrative Assistant were consulted, as well as the Human Resources Manager, who submitted the draft survey to the Joint Accessibility Advisory Committee.

Q4 Currently, what is your primary source of transportation? Please select one:







Q6 What is the nature of your disability? Please check all that apply.



Q7 Do you use a mobility aid?




Q8 Have you ever used the Route 10 bus with its accessible features as described in the Background Information for this survey?

Q9 Does your disability prevent you from using the conventional Route 10 bus?




Q10 Have you ever used an accessible taxi?





Q16 As a person with a disability, would a specialized transit service result in a significantly improved lifestyle for you?


