**Outdoor Water Use Ban Partially Lifted**

**Alternate Day Water Conservation Measures To Remain In Effect**

Please be advised that Loyalist Township has partially lifted the water ban on outdoor water use. Effective immediately, outdoor use of water supplied from the Fairfield Water System (Amherstview, Odessa, Harewood and Brooklands) will be limited to alternate days based on your civic address number. Residences with even numbers are allowed outdoor use of water on even calendar days and those with odd numbers are allowed outdoor use of water on odd calendar days. The restriction on outdoor use of water includes watering of lawns and gardens, car washing, pool filling and driveway cleaning. This mandatory limitation will be strictly enforced.

The Fairfield Plant has recently experienced unusually high demands, partially due to the recent dry weather and some major leaks in the system. Several leaks were identified and repaired over the past few weeks.

The Township appreciates the patience and cooperation of residents during the recent total outdoor water use ban. Residents are cautioned that, should demand on the Fairfield Water System increase substantially, a total ban may have to be considered again. You are asked to remember that water is a valuable resource that must be used carefully and responsibly.

Residents who have recently placed sod are requested to contact the Township Office at 386-7351, ext. 116, for further instructions regarding the alternate day restrictions.
