Loyalist Township is examining alternatives to optimize the performance of the Amherstview Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). As part of the study, biosolids (sludge) management alternatives are being evaluated. One of the alternatives for sludge management includes septage treatment for properties within the municipal boundaries consistent with the requirements of the Nutrient Management Act. Alternatives being examined include dewatering and transfer of sludge to an approved landfill site and stabilization and land application of sludge on agricultural land.

In accordance with requirements for Schedule B projects under the provisions of the Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Water and Wastewater Projects (2000), the Township is making study material, plans, cost estimates and a preliminary design available for public review at an open house to be held as follows:
