



**2010 MUNICIPAL ELECTION
NOTICE TO CANDIDATES**

Every person who proposes to be a candidate in the 2010 Municipal Election must file a Nomination Paper with the Clerk of the Municipality for which you are proposing to be a candidate by **2:00 p.m. on Friday, September 10, 2010.**

The Municipal Elections Act prohibits a candidate from soliciting or accepting contributions for the purpose of the election or incurring campaign expenses until that person has filed a Nomination Paper with **the Returning Officer responsible for the election.**

The Municipal Elections Act, Section 68(1) 1. states that the election campaign begins on the day a nomination for the office is filed under Section 33 of the Act.

Nomination Procedure

A person may be nominated for an office by filing a Nomination Paper in the Election Office responsible for the Election (this varies for school board trustees). The nomination shall:

1. be in the prescribed form which is available from the Clerk's office.
2. be accompanied by a Consent to the Nomination and a Declaration of Qualification.
3. be accompanied by the prescribed Nomination filing fee (\$200.00 for Reeve and \$100.00 for all other offices, in the form of cash or certified cheque payable to the Municipality).

The nomination may be filed:

1. on any day in the year of the regular election that is before nomination day, at a time when the Clerk's office is open.
2. on Nomination Day, **Friday, September 10, 2010**, between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
