



## **NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE BABCOCK MILL DAM**

Loyalist Township has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed removal, rehabilitation or replacement of the Babcock Mill Dam, located on Millhaven Creek, downstream of the Village of Odessa.

The Township planned the project under Schedule "B" of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.

Public and agency consultation is an important component of the Environmental Assessment process. Public and agency input are invited for incorporation into the planning and design of the project. A Public Information Centre (PIC) for this project was held earlier in 2011 to receive input from the public for the project.

The Township's council has selected the replacement of the existing dam with a Combination of Overflow Structure and Gate/Log Bay as the preferred alternative for the dam.

Subject to the comments received and the receipt of the necessary approvals, Loyalist Township intends to proceed with the detail design and construction of this project as detailed.

If concerns arise regarding this project, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Township, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environment assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below by February 13, 2012. A copy of this request must also be sent to the Township's Transportation and Solid Waste Manager. If there is no request received by February 13, 2012, the project will proceed to design and construction as presented in the EA file.
