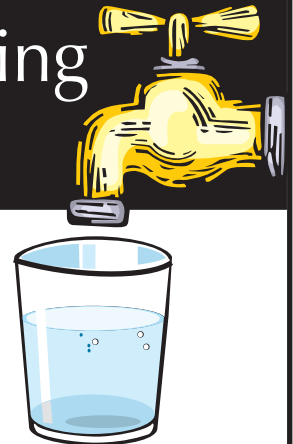

The Cataraqui Source Protection Committee is hosting a series of open houses to get your ideas and suggestions on our work plan for drinking water source protection.

Our work plan, or *terms of reference*, will determine what will be studied and which areas will be examined as we work towards preparing a plan to protect drinking water sources. This is a long-term process to be completed by 2012.

The open houses are scheduled from **6:00 to 8:30 p.m.** with a presentation at **7:00 p.m.** Please drop by and talk to our staff and Source Protection Committee members about our work plan and learn about drinking water source protection. You may attend any of the following open houses:

- ◆ **Thursday, May 22, 2008** - Bath Fire Hall, 241 Church Street, Bath
