



WHAT IS MFIPPA?

Ontario's Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, (the Act), provides individuals with a right of access to both general information and their own personal information maintained by municipal government, including local agencies, boards and commissions.

A decision by a municipal government, agency, board or commission to deny access to certain types of information can be appealed to the [Information and Privacy Commissioner/Ontario \(IPC/O\)](#).

The Act also provides a privacy protection scheme relating to the collection, use, disclosure and retention of personal information in the custody and/or control of municipal governments.

There is a mandatory \$5.00 application fee which must accompany each request for information.

Depending on the nature of your request (general records or a request for your own personal information) or the volume of records requested, additional processing costs may apply to your request.
