

BLUE BOX

Place clean food, beverage and household containers loosely in the Blue Box. **DO NOT** bag Blue Box items.

Plastic/Styrofoam

Include: Plastic bottles, jars, tubs and lids, cartons, trays, clamshell and other rigid plastic packaging.

Styrofoam pieces must be no longer than 90cm x 60cm x 20cm.

Do not include: Plastic pails over 10 litres, toys, laundry baskets, storage totes, popcorn styrofoam or large plastics that are not a food, beverage or household container or rigid package.

Glass

Include: clear and coloured glass bottles and jars. Return beer and alcohol bottles to The Beer Store for a refund.

Do not include: broken glass, window panes, mirrors, lightbulbs, ceramics or drinking glasses.

Aluminum and Steel

Include: metal food and beverage cans. Metal lids can be placed inside a can and pinched shut. Labels do not need to be removed. Paper cans with metal ends (i.e. coffee cans, chip cans, nut cans, frozen juice cans etc).

GREY BOX

Paper Products

Include: newspaper, white paper, coloured paper, colour flyers, catalogues, telephone books, soft cover books, magazines, envelopes, and hard cover books with the cover removed. Place in a clean, untied grocery or paper bag or tie in bundles. This stops the paper from blowing away. **Do not include:** gift wrap.

Plastic Bags

Place all clean bags into an empty bag and tie shut.

Include: grocery bags, milk bags/milk pouches, frozen vegetable bags, and newspaper sleeves.

Do not include: cereal/cracker box liners, plastic food wrap, zipper-type storage bags, diapers, meat/bacon packaging, "crinkly" outer packaging (e.g. pasta wrappers), pet food bags, or bubble wrap.

Boxboard & Polycoat

Polycoat - Rinse and flatten milk cartons, juice cartons and Tetra-Pak juice boxes. Place together with boxboard.

Boxboard - Flatten and bundle or place inside another box.

Include: cereal/cracker boxes, frozen food boxes, egg cartons, paper towel tubes, drink trays, and greeting cards.

Corrugated Cardboard

Remove staples and tape. Flatten and bundle no bigger than 90cm x 60cm x 20 cm. There is a six bundle limit per collection. Place bundles beside your Grey Box.

Do not include: wax-coated boxes or soiled pizza boxes.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) should NEVER be placed in the recycling or garbage. Items can be brought to the Kingston Area Recycling Centre (KARC) free of charge or go to www.makethedrop.ca to find local retailers who accept certain HHW items.
