

# Notice of Commencement



## Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for the Amherstview Water Pollution Control Plant

Loyalist Township has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to determine the preferred design to increase plant capacity at the Amherstview Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). The intent of the EA is to guide the Township's efforts in addressing the following problem statement:

To identify and describe the preferred design solution for provision of additional wastewater treatment capacity at the Amherstview WPCP to meet future growth and effluent quality requirements, while minimizing impacts on the natural and social/cultural environment and optimizing capital and operating investments. To consider implementation of improvements at the existing facility to allow for increased operational flexibility and performance.

The study is being conducted in accordance with the requirements for Phases 3 and 4 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, as amended in 2007) process. This undertaking is considered a Schedule C project. This study builds on the previously completed Sewage Disposal Master Plan, which addressed Phases 1 and 2 of the Class EA process. The preferred solution from the Master Plan process was the expansion of wastewater treatment capacity at the Amherstview WPCP.

Your feedback is an important part of the consultation process. Community participation will form a part of the report and final recommendation. A public information centre will be held at a future date to present information regarding the project for comment.
