Statutory Public Meeting for items under the Planning Act

<u>Public Meeting- Zoning By-law Amendment Applications - Emma Street - Block 31 29M-57 (D14-014-2023), Block 34 29M-57 (D14-011-2023), Lots 215-216 Plan-91 (D14-015-2023)</u>

A public meeting was held in accordance with the provisions of the *Planning Act*, to consider three Zoning By-law Amendment Applications - Emma Street - Block 31 29M-57 (D14-014-2023), Block 34 29M-57 (D14-011-2023) and Lots 215-216 Plan-91 (D14-015-2023) and that a recommendation be brought forward to Council once the comments from the Township departments, agencies and the public have been addressed.

<u>Public Meeting/ Recommendation - Payne Funeral Home - Zoning By-law Amendment (D14-008-2023)</u>

A public meeting was held in accordance with the provisions of the *Planning Act* to consider By-Law 2023-078, being a by-law to rezone the part of property found in Part of Lot 75-76, Plan 91, as in Part 1 on Plan 29R4449; Loyalist Township, County of Lennox and Addington, and more particularly located at 42 William Street, in Odessa from the Residential Type 1 (R1) Zone to Open Space Exception Seven (OS-07) Zone.

<u>Tile Drainage Loan Program - Borrowing By-law</u>

Council approved the additional borrowing of \$300,000 under the *Tile Drainage* sought from the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food, and Rural Affairs to aid in the construction of drainage works under the *Tile Drainage Act*.

Odessa and Wilton Flower Barrel Agreement

Council directed the Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer to enter into the Odessa and Wilton Flower Barrel Agreement to formalize the provision of flower barrels in select locations within Odessa and Wilton.

<u>Committee of Adjustment and Appeals Committee - Terms of Reference</u>

Council approved the Terms of Reference for the Loyalist Township Committee of Adjustment and Appeals Committee, By-law 2023-84, Being a By-law to Establish and Adopt Terms of Reference for the Loyalist Township Committee of Adjustment be enacted and passed; and By-law 2023-85, Being a By-law to Establish and Adopt Terms of Reference for the Loyalist Township Appeals Committee.

Council approved <u>By-Law 2023-088</u> to appoint Livestock Valuers Adam Miller, Paul Chapman, Angela Kent, Joanne D'Amore, Brennan Lambert and Carl Hanna for Loyalist Township.
