The winning design will be printed for the 2024 Bath Canada Day button.

Cash prizes will be awarded of \$50 to the winner and \$25 to the 3 runners-up.

The winning designs will be posted on the Loyalist Township website and social media.

Prizes will be presented at the Opening Ceremony in Bath on July 1st.

Please ensure the final copy of your button is attached to a completed entry form with signed permission by a parent or legal guardian and dropped off at your child's school, or at either Municipal office located at: 263 Main Street Odessa or 18 Manitou Crescent West by 3:00 p.m. by Friday, April 19th.

Designs will be given to the Bath Artisans for judging the week of April 22nd.

The winning artists will be notified Friday, April 26th.

The winner will be the Parade Grand Marshall, riding in the parade with their immediate family.

No personal information will be shared with judges or volunteers. Entries will be labeled with a number. Township staff will be the point of contact with the winning artists. All personal information provided will only be used by Township staff and will be stored securely.

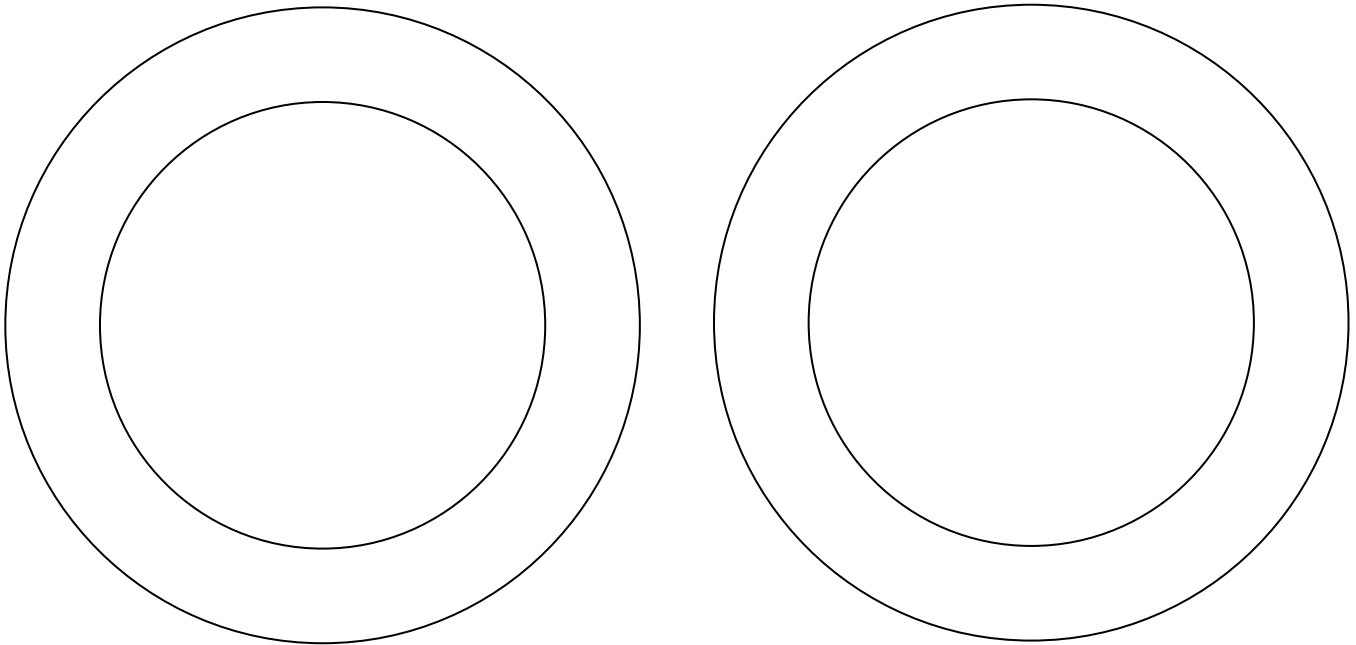

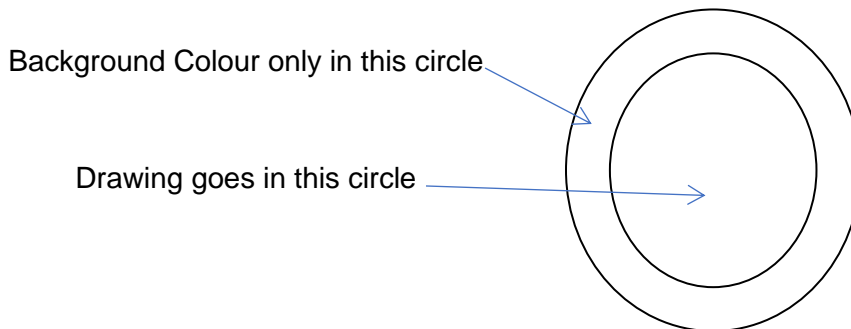

 - Brighter colours make for a more colourful button.

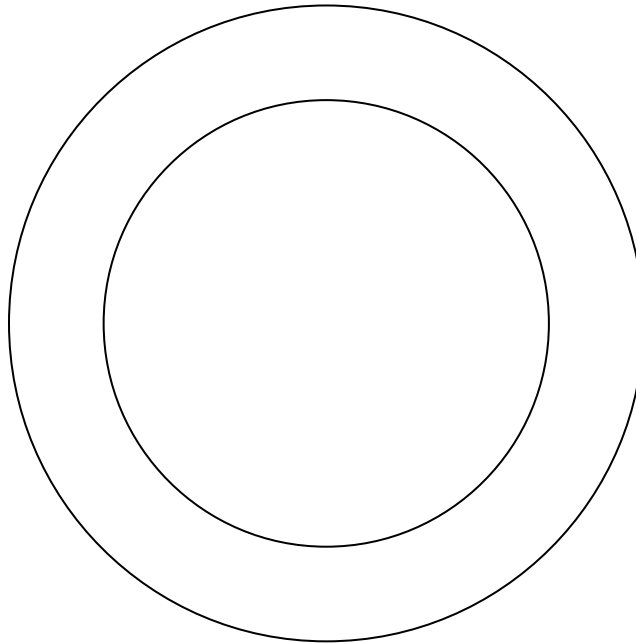
